

The Undersigned, being sworn says, on Information and belief, that RAYMOND LEE DAVIS, JR, ROBERT B GIBSON and SCOTTY LEE WASHINGTON, JR did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about August 12, 2007, commit a Felony, to wit: KIDNAPPING FOR RANSOM, a violation of section 209(a) of the PENAL CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) did unlawfully seize, confine, inveigle, entice, decoy, abduct, conceal, kidnap, and carry away JANE DOE with the intent to hold and detain, and who did hold and detain, the said JANE DOE for ransom, reward, extortion, and to exact from relatives and friends of said JANE DOE money and other valuable things, to wit: cash and computer equipment.



- That the contents of this declaration provides probable cause to believe the above-named defendant committed the following offenses:

3. The following is a summary of the listed offense(s):

The 15-year-old victim made allegations that she had been held at the Oakland residence of suspect Raymond Davis since 16 July 2007. The victim said that Davis provided her with hallucinogen drugs, and forced her to have sex with unknown male subjects. The victim said that she left Davis' residence, and stayed in a Hayward Area hotel with an associate of Davis, who she believed was her friend.


The victim said that during the morning of 12 August 2007, Davis and two accomplices located the victim in Hayward. The victim said that she was beaten by the suspects, and forced to leave the hotel against her will. The victim said that while she was being driven back to Davis' residence, Davis forced her to call her mother (witness Deborah Perry). The victim heard Davis demanding that Perry provide him with a computer, digital music player, and currency in exchange for her safe return.

Perry agreed to meet with the suspects. Perry met with the suspects briefly, before being told to go to a location in order to purchase items to exchange for the victim. Perry then contacted Oakland police, and advised them of the agreed upon meeting place. Oakland police responded and detained Davis, along with with two accomplices. Perry identified Davis as being one of the subjects that tried to extort items from her.

The victim was subsequently contacted, and identified Davis as one of the involved subjects.






